Terms and Conditions of Temporary STN AnaVist Login ID

1. Participation in the STN AnaVist Test Projects Program is by invitation only.
2. By signing this Test Projects Request form, customer agrees to be bound by the STN AnaVist License Agreement and CAS Information Use Policies. The Requester can refer STN Login IDs for Shared Projects holders to www.cas.org/legal/infopolicy.html for CAS Information Use Policies as well as to their service center's web site (www.cas.org for STN-Columbus customers, www.stn-international.de for STN-Karlsruhe customers, and www.jaici.or.jp for STN-Tokyo customers).
3. Upon acceptance, customer is supplied with a temporary STN Login ID for use solely with STN AnaVist and STN AnaVist Test Projects. This Login ID has limited capabilities and is used by the customer to download a copy of the STN AnaVist software or to order a CD copy of the software. The temporary STN Login ID also allows access to up to two (2) STN AnaVist Test Projects as chosen by the customer. The Login ID cannot be used for initiating new STN AnaVist projects, for STN searching, or for any other purposes.
4. There is no fee to acquire the temporary STN AnaVist Login ID. When using this Login ID, usage fees normally associated with STN AnaVist (visualization fees, record display fees, and long-term storage fees for saved projects) are waived. Usage of these Login IDs is monitored.
5. Temporary STN AnaVist Login IDs issued under this program expire 60 days after issuance, and customer STN AnaVist Test Projects (including any editing of the projects) are deleted.
6. Sharing of temporary STN AnaVist Login IDs issued under this program is prohibited.
