

## SciFinder<sup>®</sup> Speed of Discovery Tournament Rules

### Official Rules

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. ALL APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL, AND MUNICIPAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS APPLY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

By entering the SciFinder<sup>®</sup> Speed of Discovery Tournament (the “Contest”), you (the “Entrant”) agree to comply with, and be bound by, the following official Contest rules (the “Rules”). PLEASE REVIEW THE RULES CAREFULLY.

1. **Eligibility.** The Contest is open only to individuals who have reached the age of majority in their jurisdiction of residence at the time of entry, and do not reside in a jurisdiction in which this Contest is prohibited or otherwise restricted by law, rule or regulation. Employees and contractors of the American Chemical Society, CAS, ACS International, Ltd., FIZ Karlsruhe GmbH, JAICI, and their immediate family members (spouse, parent, child, sibling, and their respective spouses, regardless of where they live) or persons living in the same households of such employees or contractors, whether or not related, are not eligible to enter the Contest. Entrants must be attending the ACS National Meeting & Expo in San Diego, California, USA, August 25-27, 2019 (the “ACS Meeting”).
  2. **Sponsor.** The Contest is fully sponsored by CAS (the “Sponsor”), a division of the American Chemical Society, located at 2540 Olentangy River Road, Columbus, Ohio 43202-1505, United States. The Contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed, administered, or associated with Amazon.com, Inc., Apple, Inc., or Sony Corporation of America.
  3. **How to Enter.** Entrant must attend the ACS Meeting. Entrants must visit the ACS booth and use complimentary SciFinder<sup>®</sup> access to answer a question provided by CAS. The correct answer to the question must be submitted by Entrant via the online submission form in the booth by noon on Tuesday, August 27, 2019 for a chance to be selected for the tournament. At 1 pm Tuesday, August 27, 2019:
    - a. Eight (8) Entrants submitting the correct answer will be randomly selected to participate in the tournament to take place at 3 pm on Tuesday, August 27, 2019.
    - b. Three (3) Entrants submitting the correct answer, but who cannot attend the tournament, will be randomly selected to receive one of three (3) \$25 Amazon gift cards.
- All selected Entrants must be physically present at the tournament location at the time of the tournament or their position will be forfeited. CAS reserves the right to alter contest times set forth above at its convenience for any reason.
4. **Entry Guidelines.** Individuals may enter the Contest only once.
  5. **How to Win.** The Tournament participants will be paired with another Tournament participant to compete head-to-head in a contest, as determined by a judge, to use SciFinder<sup>®</sup> to correctly answer a question. Tournament participants who successfully find the correct answer first in each round will then advance to the next round until a winner is determined.
  6. **Prizes.** The Tournament Winner will receive an Apple MacBook Air and one (1) year of complimentary SciFinder<sup>®</sup> access valued at approximately \$1,399 USD. The Tournament Runner-up will receive Sony wireless, sound-canceling headphones valued at approximately \$350 USD. Two (2) Tournament Semifinalists will each receive \$100 Amazon gift cards and four (4) Tournament Quarterfinalists will each receive \$50 Amazon gift cards. No prize substitution except by the Sponsor due to prize unavailability for any reason and then for a

prize of equal value. Applicable taxes and unspecified expenses in conjunction with prize acceptance/use are the prize winner's sole responsibility. Restrictions, conditions, and limitations apply. By entering, the Entrant further agrees that, in the event that there is any conflict or other inconsistency between the Rules and any advertisements, Contest or marketing materials, emails or announcements relevant to the Contest, these Rules will govern. Any disputes arising out of or related to the Contest shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the District of Columbia (without regard to conflict of law principles). Should any part of these Rules be held invalid or unenforceable, that portion shall be construed consistent with applicable law and the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.
