TRANSFER for crossfile searching

TRANSFER automatically extracts up to 50,000 terms from an L-number answer set and searches extracted data in one or more target databases.

Find patents on the drug Prozac.

- 1 Search REGISTRY for the CAS Registry Number[®] of the substance.
- 2 In the desired database(s), search the REGISTRY answer set (L1) and limit to patents.
- 3 To find relevant patents in WPINDEX, use the TRANSFER command. Enter the L-number from which terms should be extracted (L2), number of answers, and one or more fields from which to extract.
- 4 Enter SET DUPORDER FILE to group answers by database.
- 5 (Optional) Remove duplicates to create one answer set from all databases searched.
- 6 Display some answers. The HIT format shows the search terms causing the retrieval.
